


#### The ABC's of the Bible

Every child must be taught the definition and meaning of words in the Bible as well as any other book – even the very simple or elementary words. So then, why the yell and cry of these dishonest and blind theologians that children don't understand the true Word of God, the King James Version of the Bible? 





QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is the profile of a sinner before getting saved? Foolish, disobedient, deceived, hateful, etc. Cf. Titus 3:3.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What kind of people were the Cretians where Titus was pastor? Liars and lazy gluttons. Cf. Titus 1:12-13.



QUESTION: ANSWER:	Describe the wisdom that comes from God. Full of mercy, pure, peaceable, etc. Cf. James 3:17.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	Who is an enemy of God? A friend of this evil world. Cf. James 4:4; I John 2:15-16.

QUESTION: ANSWER:	How brief is our lifespan on this earth? Like a vapour that appeareth briefly. Cf. James 4:14.

- QUESTION: Did the Apostle Peter warn Christians they would suffer for Christ's sake?
- ANSWER: Yes indeed. Cf. I Peter 1:7; 2:19-21; 3:14, 17; 4:1, 12-13; 5:10.

### II Peter

QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is the central theme of this apostolic epistle? Warnings of the greatest danger to a Christian – false prophets. Cf. II Peter 2:1-3, 12-22.
QUESTION:	Apostle Peter wrote this epistle from death row in a Roman prison. What was the burden of the warn-ings of which he wrote?
ANSWER:	"We have not followed cunningly devised fables," but was writing the sure Word of God. Cf. II Peter 1:16.
QUESTION:	What is the spiritual profile of a crooked preacher or false prophet?
ANSWER:	They are greedy for money and immoral. Cf. II Peter 2:12-15.
QUESTION:	What responsibility does Peter remind Christians of?
ANSWER:	They are to believe the Holy Prophets of the Old Testament, and the writings of Christ's Apostles. Cf. II Peter 3:1-2.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	How does God Almighty reckon time? One day is as a thousand years, a thousand years as a day. Cf. II Peter 3:8.
QUESTION:	What is this Apostle's prophecy for our endtime generation?
ANSWER:	The earth and the works therein shall be burned up. Cf. II Peter 3:10.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	How are we instructed to escape this destruction? God is not willing that any should perish in this prophesied destruction, but that ALL should come to REPENTANCE. Cf. II Peter 3:9.

### I, II, and III John

- QUESTION: What is the central theme of these three Bible epistles? ANSWER: LOVE, God's love for us, and a command for us to love God and other Christians. Cf. I John 2:4, 10; 3:1, 11, 16-18; 4:7-12, 16-21; 5:2-3.
- QUESTION: How do we show openly that we love God? ANSWER: By keeping His commandments. Cf. I John 2:3-5; 5:2-3.
- QUESTION: A counterfeit of Jesus Christ is coming what did John call him?
- ANSWER: The Antichrist. Cf. I John 2:18, 22; 4:3; II John 7. These are the only places in the Bible that "Antichrist" is used.
- QUESTION: How are we taught to keep from committing sin? ANSWER: Abide in Christ. Cf. I John 3:6-10.
- QUESTION: What is John's definition of sin? ANSWER: Disobeying God's Law – the Ten Commandments. Cf. I John 3:4.
- QUESTION:Is there another way to go to Heaven except by Jesus?ANSWER:NO!Cf. I John 5:11-12; John 14:6; II John 9.

#### Jude

QUESTION: What is the theme of this epistle? ANSWER: The Lord will come with ten thousands of His saints to execute judgment upon the ungodly. Cf. Jude 14-15.

QUESTION:	What is Jude's grave warning to sanctified Chris- tians?
ANSWER:	Ungodly men would come here in our generation who would turn God's GRACE into lasciviousness – living disgracefully, calling it GRACE. Cf. Jude 4, 10, 16.
QUESTION:	What Old Testament prophet was Jude quoting from?

ANSWER:	In everlasting chains under darkness. Cf. Jude 6.
QUESTION:	What happened to the wicked citizens of Sodom and Gomorrha?
ANSWER:	They suffered God's vengeance of eternal fire. Cf. Jude 7
QUESTION:	All the apostles of Christ have warned us of what mortal danger to Christians in our endtime age?
ANSWER:	That there would be mockers or hypocrites among Christ's disciples to mislead and fool them. Cf. Jude 17-19.


QUESTION: ANSWER:	Who was the author of this prophetic book? The Apostle John from the Revelation of Jesus Christ. Cf. Revelation 1:1, 19.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	Where was John when he wrote the Revelation? The island of Patmos in the Mediterranean Sea – a Roman exile prison camp. Cf. Revelation 1:9.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is the central theme of Revelation? Jesus' coming to earth as King of Kings and Lord of Lords. Cf. Revelation 1:7-8; 19:16.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	How did this revelation of Christ affect John? He fell at His feet as dead. Cf. Revelation 1:13-18.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	The words of Jesus Christ in chapters 2 & 3 were written to whom? To the seven churches in Asia.
ANSWER.	To the seven churches in Asia.
QUESTION:	Which church was symbolic of today's church, lukewarm, and rejected by Jesus?
ANSWER:	The church at Laodicea – spewed out of His mouth. Cf. Revelation 3:14-16.
QUESTION:	John wrote of the Great Tribulation Period arising. How did it begin?
ANSWER:	He saw four horses and horsemen taking peace from the earth. Cf. Revelation 6:1-8.

QUESTION: ANSWER:	How many Jews will escape the Great Tribulation? 144,000. Cf. Revelation 7:1-4; 14:1-3.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	How many Christians will be saved that came out of great tribulation? A great multitude without number. Cf. Revelation 7:9, 14.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	When does the Great Tribulation increase in inten- sity? When seven angels sound seven trumpets. Cf. Revelation 8:6.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	When will men cry for death and they cannot die? When scorpions out of hell sting men for five months. Cf. Revelation 9:1-6.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	Is Revelation written in a chronological sequence? No! Chapters 6 through 14 contain parenthetical unveiling of the Tribulation Period.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What are the TWO great divisions of the 7-year Tribulation Period? 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years of the great Judgments of God – 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years of God's wrath. Cf. Revelation 15:4; Isaiah 26:9; Revelation 15:5-7; 16:1; Revelation 14:6-7.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is God's great objective in the 3-½ years of severe judgments? Restoration of His lukewarm church. Cf. Revelation 11:3-13; Matthew 17:10-11; Acts 3:19-21.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	Who will be the leaders of RESTORATION to Christ's backslidden church? ELIJAH & ENOCH, two prophets who never died. Cf. Malachi 4:5-6; Hebrews 11:5.

QUESTION:	When will the greatest mystery of all ages occur, that is, the resurrection and rapture of Christ's saints?
ANSWER:	At the last trumpet, after the first 3 ½ years of the Tribulation. Cf. I Corinthians 15:51-53; Revelation 10:7; 11:15; I Thessalonians 4:13.
QUESTION:	Will Christ's true church go into the Tribulation period?
ANSWER:	YES indeed! Until Elijah and Enoch finish their 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> years of prophesying and Christ's church is RESTORED back to Holiness, its first love, and unity.
QUESTION:	After 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> years of their great prophetic ministry they are killed. By whom?
ANSWER:	The Antichrist. His symbolic name is "The Beast." Cf. Revelation 11:7.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What names are used for the Devil in Revelation? The great dragon, that old serpent, Devil, and Satan. Cf. Revelation 12:9.
QUESTION:	Who are Satan's surrogates who will deceive the whole world?
ANSWER:	The Antichrist and the False Prophet. Cf. Revela- tion 13:1-3, 8, 11-14; 19:20; 20:10.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is the mark of the Beast? 666! Cf. Rev. 13:16-18.
QUESTION:	What is God's judgment upon those who worship the Antichrist and worship his image?
ANSWER:	They will be cast into the bottomless pit forever. Cf. Revelation 14:9-11.

- QUESTION: Blood will be how deep in the Battle of Armageddon?
- ANSWER: To the horse bridles or 6 feet deep. Cf. Revelation 14:18-20; 16:16.
- QUESTION: In the last 3-1/2 years of the Great Tribulation, how is God's wrath accomplished?
- ANSWER: Seven angels pour out seven vials of God's wrath. Cf. Revelation 15:6-8; 16:1.
- QUESTION: Which vial contained the greatest destruction upon the earth?
- ANSWER: The seventh vial. The cities of the nations were destroyed and mountains were removed by the most devastating earthquake in history. Cf. Revelation 16:17-21.
- QUESTION: What does the elegantly dressed woman of Revelation 17 called MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH symbolize?
- ANSWER: World religions that are pagan and do not live by nor believe God's Word. Cf. Revelation 17:4-6, 15, 18 (Rome); Revelation 18:24.
- QUESTION: The Bride of Christ is revealed in Revelation. How and where?
- ANSWER: Revelation 19:7-9; 21:1-2; 19:11-14; 21:9.
- QUESTION: How long will Christians live and reign with Christ on this earth in the Kingdom of Heaven?
- ANSWER: 1,000 years! Cf. Revelation 20:4-5.
- QUESTION:Where will all of Christ's enemies be?ANSWER:Cast into the Lake of Fire, the second death. Cf.<br/>Revelation 20:1-3, 10, 15.

QUESTION:	After Christ's 1,000-year reign, what will earth's next government be?
ANSWER:	The Kingdom of God ruled by God the Father. Cf. Revelation 21:1-5; I Corinthians 15:24-28.
QUESTION:	The Tree of Life was first in the Garden of Eden. Where is it now?
ANSWER:	In Heaven near the Throne of God. Cf. Rev. 22:1-3.
QUESTION:	Through eternity who will have access to the Tree of Life?
ANSWER:	Those who obey God's Commandments. Cf. Revelation 22:14.
QUESTION:	Jesus has confirmed that the prophecies of Revela- tion are warnings written to whom?
ANSWER:	To Christ's churches. Cf. Revelation 22:16-17.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is the penalty for changing God's Word? God will put the plagues of Revelation on a person, and take his part out of the Book of Life. Cf. Revelation 22:18-19.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	What is another name for the Book of Revelation? The APOCALYPSE.
QUESTION:	Why could Christ and His angel proclaim to John that "the time is at hand" for these prophecies to be fulfilled?
ANSWER:	Because a day with the Lord is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as a day. Cf. Revelaion 1:1; 22:6, 10; II Peter 3:8.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	How large is Heaven? 1500 miles square. Cf. Revelation 21:16.
QUESTION: ANSWER:	Heaven is a city. Will it ever come to earth? YES! Cf. Rev. 21:1,10-11; 22:14.




